1. JAMES D.¹ LITTLEWORTH was born 1781 in Hampshire England, and died April 25, 1873 in Plympton Twp Lambton Ontario^{1,2}. He married MARGARET LANDWARD Unknown.

"Another Veteran Gone.---Our Matlock correspondent advises us this week of the death of Sgt. Littleworth of the Township of Plympton (near Camlachie) well known throughout the county on account of his long residence in it at, it is believed, the age of ninety-four years. His death took place on Friday 25th ult. He has been in a failing state of health the greatest part of the winter but was able to go about until within a few weeks of his death; and though his physical system had been gradually sinking for many years past in consequence of his great age, he retained his mental faculties in wonderful vigor to the last. He was one of the early settlers of Plympton having settled there in 1833; so that he had been a resident of that township for forty years. His remains were consigned to their last resting place on Sabbath, 27th ult. the funeral service being performed by the Rev. Mr. Daniels, W.(esleyan) M.(ethodist.) Deceased was a native of Hampshire, England and joined the army when he was relatively young. He possessed a robust frame and good constitution which stood him in good stead for the Peninsular War, in many actions of which he took part. He was with Sir John Moore in the retreat on Corunna, afterwards serving under Wellington 'til 1815. At the close of the war he was discharged with a pension and after a number of years spent in various places he ultimately settled down in Plympton at the time stated.

When the rebellion broke out in 1837 he again entered the ranks and did good service til it was put down and quiet and order restored in 1838; and even at the time of the great Fenian Raid, tho over four score, he shouldered his musket and walked to Sarnia, a distance of 15 miles, to join the volunteers and assist in repelling the invaders, and felt quite disappointed because his services were not accepted.

He was three times married and by his several wives has had thirty children borne to him, having married his last wife when he was over sixty years of age while she was only about fifteen."

Note: Since Plympton Twp began to be settled in 1833 Sgt. Littleworth really was one of the very early settlers here. A group of settlers came out from Sussex, England on the ship ENGLAND in the Spring of 1833 and while Sgt. Littleworth is not mentioned by name, reference is made to one of their number who was to get land because of his military service. I personally feel that referred to Sgt. Littleworth. ---Mrs. Nielsen
